Consultation – FY2020 – 2024 Consolidated Plan	Mr. Atchley provided statistics to the group regarding the FY2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan is the five-year plan that is submitted to HUD for the City’s entitlement funding for CDBG and HOME Funds. CDBG funds may be used for a wide range of community development needs, and HOME funds may only be used to create affordable housing for low-income households. Each attendee was provided with twenty-six dots to participate in providing their opinions for seven boards regarding need in Springfield. Mr. Atchley requested that if they felt items were missing from the options to choose on the boards that they write them down on a sticky note to be placed on the board. Ms. Dowler-Pryor expressed concern for the low wages in Springfield and how it is hindering people and that the cost of living is going up.
