LEST I Agreement - 1997

- **Overview of IGA**

- “This agreement provides for the consolidation of two major City and County activities”
- “there shall be a consolidated county-municipal justice center.”
- “The County shall operate and staff the justice center . . . *from the proceeds* of the law enforcement sales tax.”

- **First Four Years: 3/8 cent tax**

- “to construct and operate a consolidated justice center”
- To “implement a consolidated trunk radio system”
- Split 55% County and 45% City

LEST I – 1997 IGA (cont.)

- **Fifth Year Sunset: tax rate reduced from 3/8 cent to 1/4 cent**
 - Divided based on census population data
 - Projected split: 67% City and 33% County
 - Split adjusted every five years
 - County agrees to remit 25% of its share to other municipalities after* funding increased jail operations and communications

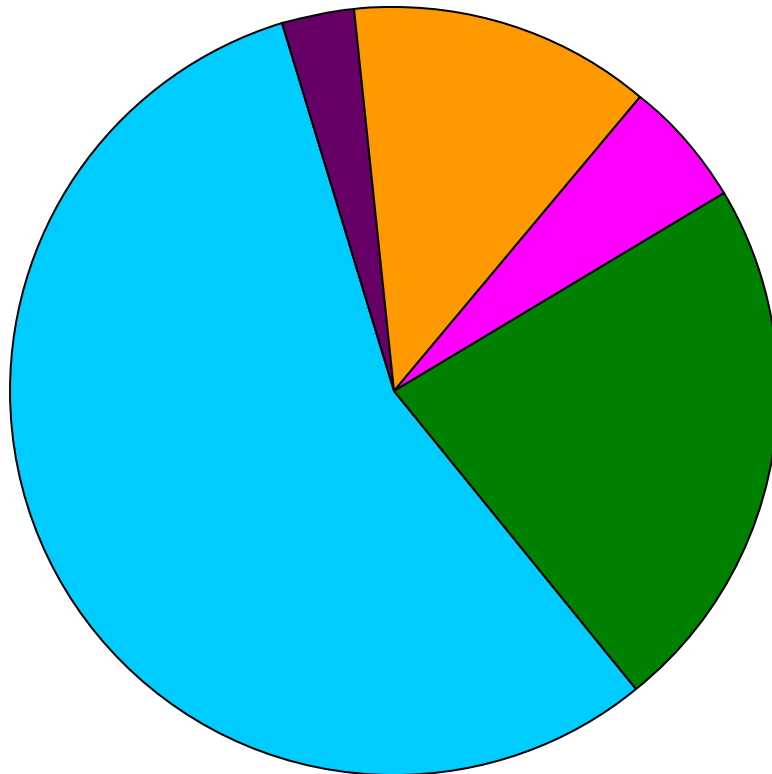
**Minimum contributions in other municipality IGA's however eliminate this limiting language*

LEST I – 1997 IGA (cont.)

- **City - in first four years**
 - 15 police officers and 3 civilian personnel each year
 - Total 60 police officers and 12 support staff
- **County agrees to**
 - Fund pro rata share of county-wide communications
 - Construct, equip and operate the justice facility
 - Remit 25% of share to other municipalities after paying for jail operations and communications
 - Add 27 positions
 - Sheriff's Office (12)
 - Juvenile Office (8)
 - Prosecutor's Office (7)

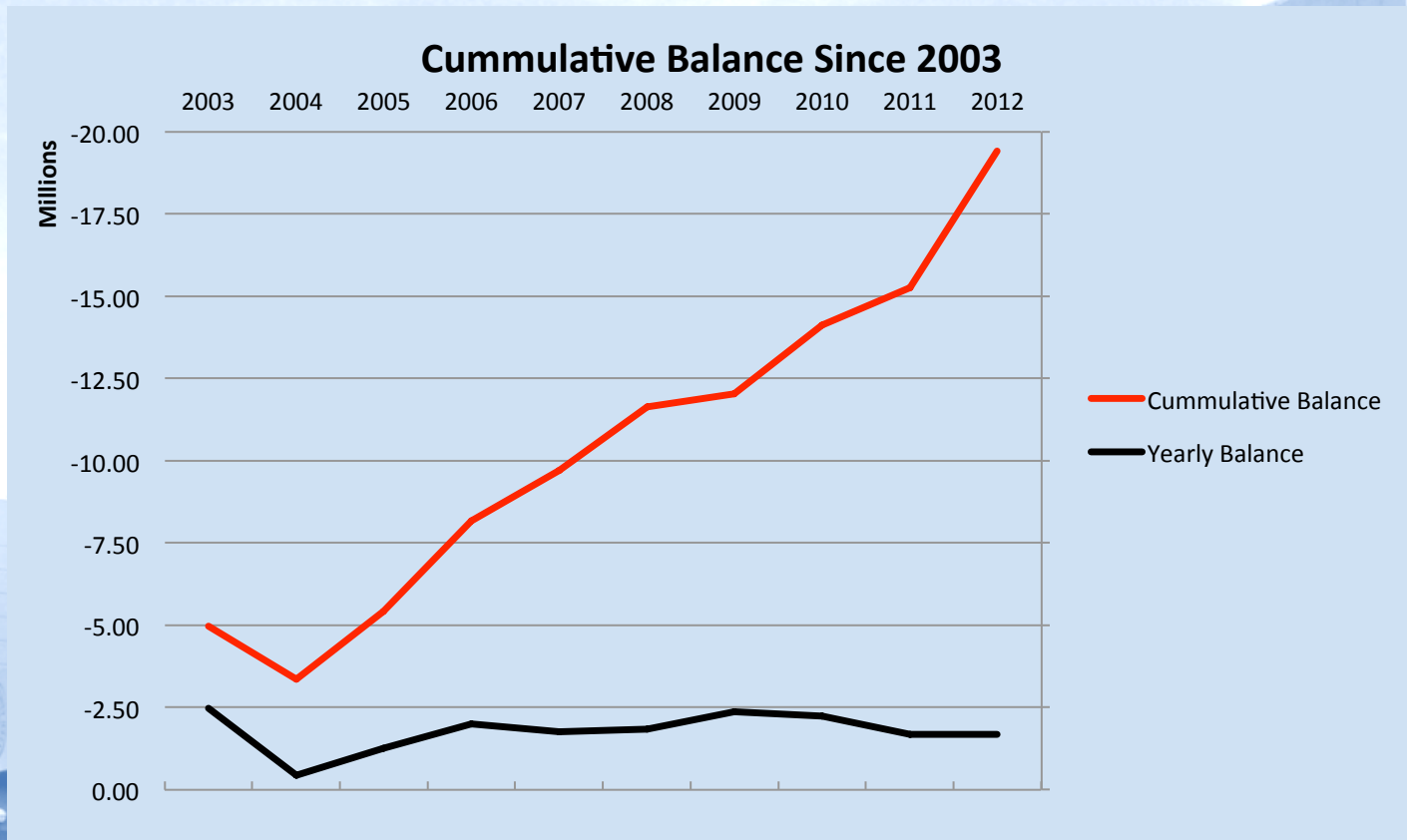
- City of Springfield 56%

 - Current Capacity: 522

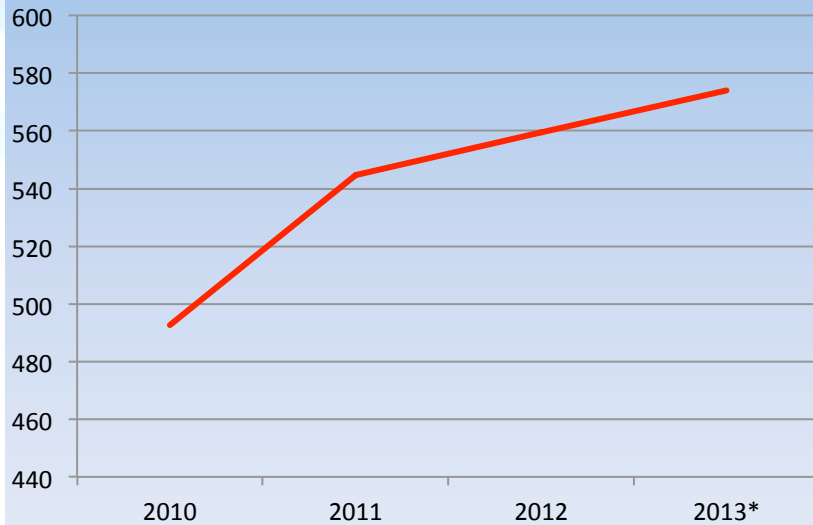

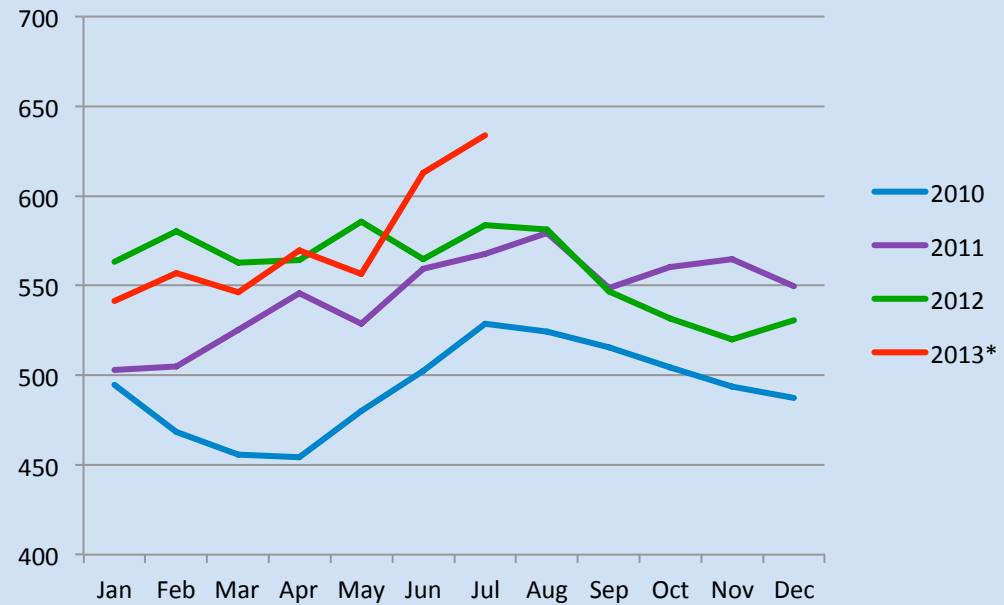
Average Inmate Population

Jail Population 2010 - 2013

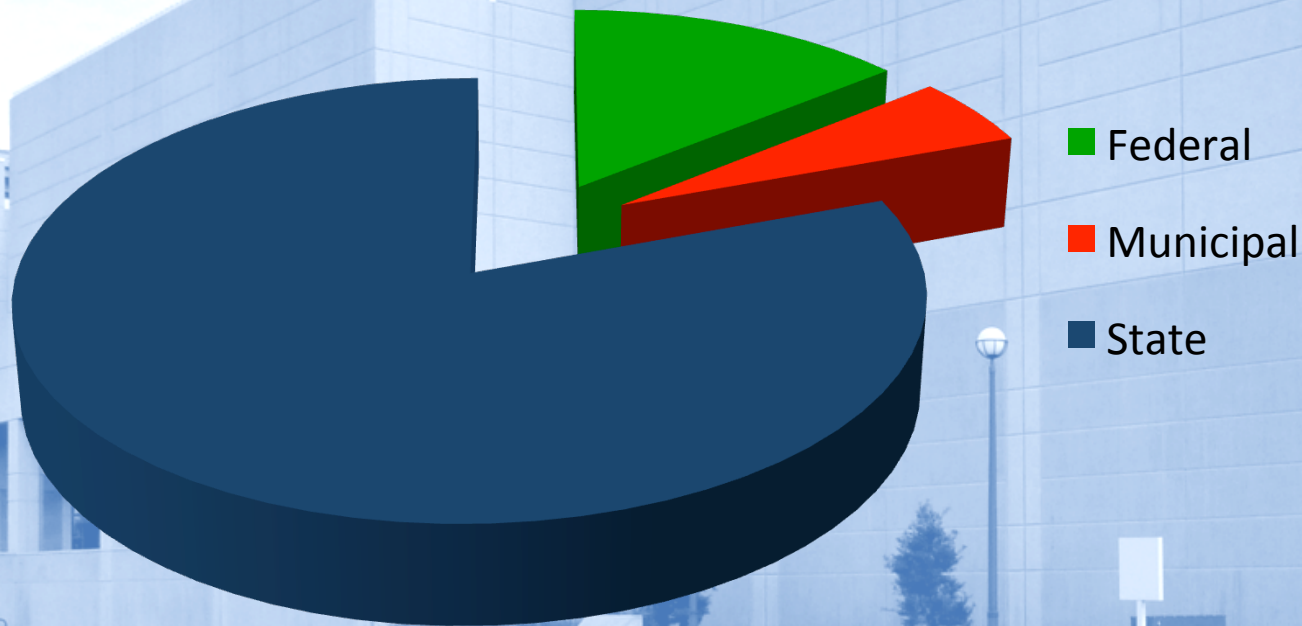


Average Inmate Population

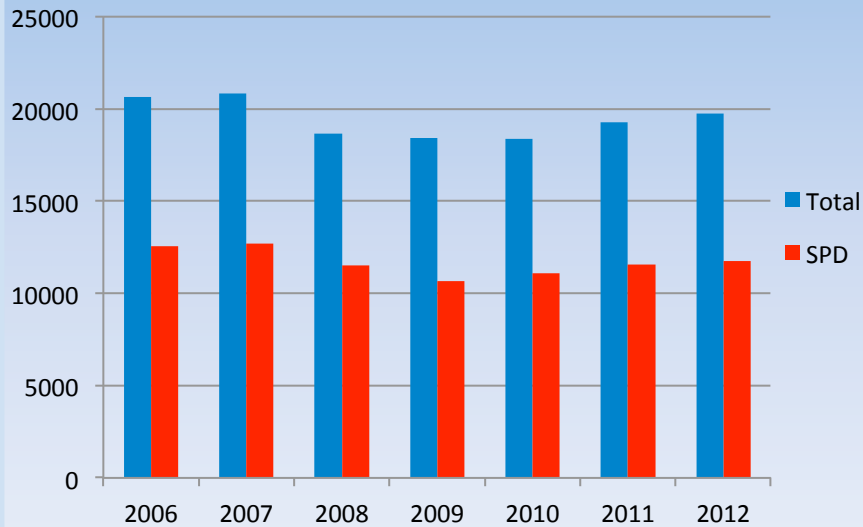

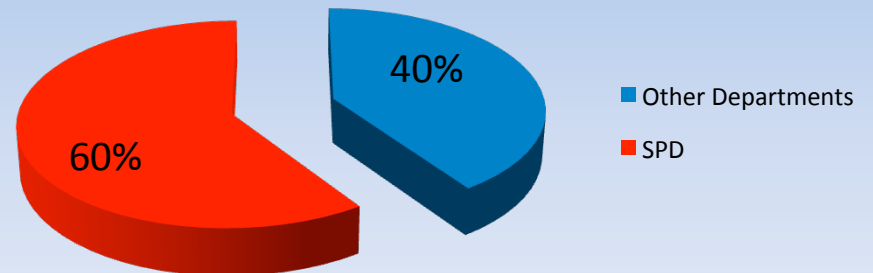
