#### 1. Landmarks Board CLG Workshop

The CLG Forum (9:00am - 5:00pm) is an annual event that allows local government and citizen leaders to connect with one another and discuss strategies for historic preservation in their communities. Featured panels and speakers this year will focus on issues faced by smaller and mid-size communities, success stories from communities across the state, and the important relationship between city staff members and volunteer appointees to local preservation commissions.
